After further discussion, the City Council by motion of Council Member Hurtado: 1) authorized the City Purchasing Agent to initiate the purchase of four (4) new police vehicles from Folsom Lake Ford and make payment at a total of \$131,663 from the Measure S fund; and 2) approved the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$50,252 to Cook's Communication of Fresno, to equip the vehicles with all necessary emergency equipment from the Measure S fund.
