

RESOLUTION NO. 3761

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SANGER CITY COUNCIL  
ESTABLISHING AND FIXING WATER SERVICES  
RATES AND CHARGES**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 23 of the Sanger City Code, 1960, authorizes the City Council by Resolution, to establish and fix rates and charges pertaining to various water related services, materials, and equipment and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it to be in the public interest to establish and fix the service rates and charges as hereinafter specified; and

**WHEREAS**, the current level of fees for water services are inadequate to cover the costs of providing such services to the users thereof, and the rates and charges set forth herein are nondiscriminatory and do not exceed the cost of providing the water services for which the rates are imposed; and

**WHEREAS**, the data substantiating the costs of providing the services for which the rates and charges are imposed were made available for public inspection at least ten (10) days prior to the public meeting at which this Resolution was adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the hearing to consider imposition of new water rates was duly given and made by publishing a notice stating the time and date of the hearing on the proposed water rate increase. The notice was duly published at least one time each week for two weeks prior to the hearing in the Sanger Herald, a newspaper published in the City of Sanger.

The time and date of the hearing is 7:00 p.m. on July 7, 2005, in Sanger city Hall, 1700 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Sanger, California.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Sanger that the rates and charges for water related services, materials and equipment are hereby established and fixed as follows:

**I. FIRE HYDRANT METERS**

- A. A deposit equal to the replacement costs of a fire hydrant meter shall be posted prior to the City installing a fire hydrant meter. This deposit shall be returned to the depositor if the meter is in satisfactory condition at the time of its return. It is the responsibility of the depositor to pay for the replacement or repair of any damaged or stolen meter.

- B. The charge for use of a fire hydrant meter shall be fifty-four dollars (\$54.00) per month or any fraction thereof during fiscal year 2005-06, fifty-nine dollars (\$59.00) per month or any fraction thereof during fiscal year 2006-07, and sixty-two dollars (\$62.00) per month or any fraction thereof during fiscal year 2006-07. The charges for water used shall be at the rates set forth in Subparagraph III, A-2 of this Resolution.
- C. The fire hydrant meter will be installed (after receipt of the deposit) and removed (upon request of the depositor) by the Department of Public Works. Water from City fire hydrants shall not be furnished, metered or sold for use outside the City.

**II. TESTING WATER METERS**

The charge for removing and bench testing water meters is forty-eight dollars (\$48.00) during fiscal year 2005-06, fifty-two dollars (\$52.00) during fiscal year 2006-07, and fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) during fiscal year 2007-08.

**III. WATER SERVICE CHARGES**

- A. With a water meter, where water is used within the City (service and usage charges):

**IV. EFFECTIVE DATE OF RESOLUTION**

A. This resolution of the Sanger City Council establishing and fixing water service rates and charges shall become effective on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2005 and shall apply to water usage beginning on that date. Water service rates and charges for fiscal year 2006-07 shall become effective on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2006, and water service rates and charges for fiscal year 2007-08 shall become effective on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2007.

**V. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX**

B. The water rates and charges in this resolution shall be adjusted beginning on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2008, and shall be adjusted each year thereafter on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June based upon the Consumer Price Index, California, All Urban Consumers for San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose (CPI). The CPI shall be calculated by taking the difference between the most recent CPI data available in April and the CPI data available in April of the previous year.
