PURPOSE

To hear public comments and to consider the elimination of marked crosswalks at the following locations:

1. 2237 Cherry Avenue (just west of Lyon Avenue)
2. 2235 Cherry Avenue (at Lyon Avenue)
3. 2195 Cherry Avenue (at George Avenue)
4. 1705 10th Street (between DeWitt Avenue and West Avenue)
5. 1601 Cherry Avenue (between Park Avenue and P Street)
6. 1498 P Street (at Edgar Avenue)
7. 1700 7th Street (at West Avenue)
8. 1105 Tucker Avenue (at North Millwood Drive intersection)
9. 1190 Tucker Avenue (at South Millwood Drive intersection)
10. 601 Faller Avenue (at Jensen Avenue)

BACKGROUND

The City is working collaboratively with Sanger Unified School District to implement a Sanger Safe Routes to School Project, which is planned to begin in June of 2018.

The intent of this State grant-funded project is to enhance school zone safety, in part by upgrading existing signage and traffic markings, including crosswalks. Some existing crosswalk locations do not have the appropriate associated infrastructure such as adjacent curb ramps, warning signage and/or pavement markings. The project design includes consolidation of such crosswalk locations to direct pedestrians to other nearby locations where the appropriate infrastructure is either in place, or is being constructed with the project.

The City is required to provide notice to the public under Section 21950.5 of the CA Vehicle Code when a crosswalk is identified for removal to ensure the public is notified and has an opportunity to comment. Notice has been posted at the sites as required.

All interested persons will be provided the opportunity to present oral comments to the City Council at the hearing prior to final Council action. Written comments may be submitted prior to the hearing on May 17, to Becky Padron, City Clerk, at 1700 7th Street, Sanger, CA 93657 or by email at bpadron@ci.sanger.ca.us. At the public hearing, Staff will summarize any comments received and present a final recommendation for City Council consideration. At the conclusion of the hearing, the City Council may choose to eliminate these crosswalks as part of the Sanger Safe Routes to School Project.

ANTECEDENTES

La Ciudad está trabajando en colaboración con el Distrito Escolar de Sanger para implementar el proyecto Sanger Safe Routes to School, que está planeado para junio de 2018.

La intención de este proyecto financiado por subsidios estatales es mejorar la seguridad de la zonas escolares, en parte actualizar la señalización existente y las marcas de tráfico, incluyendo los pasos peatonales. Algunas ubicaciones de paso de peatones existentes no tienen la infraestructura asociada apropiada, como rampas de acera adyacentes, señalización de advertencia y / o marcas en el pavimento. El diseño del proyecto incluye la consolidación de tales lugares de paso de peatones para dirigir a los peatones a otros lugares cercanos donde la infraestructura apropiada esté en su lugar, o se esté construyendo con el proyecto.

Se requiere que el público sea notificado y tenga la oportunidad de hacer comentarios y que la Ciudad proporcione un aviso al público bajo la Sección 21950.5 del Código de Vehículos de CA cuando se identifique que se vaya a remover un paso de peatones . El aviso se ha publicado en los sitios según sea necesario.

A todas las personas interesadas se les brindará la oportunidad de presentar comentarios orales al Consejo Municipal en la audiencia antes de la acción final del Consejo. Los comentarios por escrito se pueden enviar antes de la audiencia pública el 17 de mayo, a Becky Padron, Secretaria Municipal, en 1700 7th Street, Sanger, CA 93657 o por correo electrónico a bpadron@ci.sanger.ca.us. En la audiencia pública, el personal resumirá los comentarios recibidos y presentará una recomendación final para la consideración del Consejo Municipal. Al final de la audiencia, el Consejo Municipal puede elegir eliminar estos pasos peatonales como parte del Proyecto Sanger Safe Routes to School.
