City will save \$60,000 a year!

The Sanger City Council/Sanger Finance Authority Board approved the refinancing of the 2006A Bonds - Waste Water Treatment Facilities Bond.

By refinancing, the City will reduce its debt service obligation by about \$60,000 per year without extending the maturity date of the bonds. 🍀 *Good Job!*

City Council Awards Bid—2014 Cape Seal Project

As part of the City’s Pavement Management Program, the City has awarded a construction contract for the 2014 Cape Seal Project. The map to the right designates the project area which was identified and prioritized based upon the Pavement Management Program criteria.

A Cape Seal is a preventative maintenance method to extend the life of a roadway. It consists of a 2-step process which starts with the application of a rubberized asphalt mixture to seal cracks and the application of small aggregate to provide structural support. The second step is the application of a slurry seal to smooth out the road surface and fill the gaps between the chips. **The project is scheduled to begin in mid-August.**

SANGER'S EXPRESS PUBLIC TRANSIT ROUTE TO REEDLEY COLLEGE

Launch Date: August 11, 2014

On August 11, 2014 the City of Sanger, in partnership with Fresno County Rural Transit Agency, will launch a new express public transit route from the Sanger Community Center to Reedley College. The new service is open to the general public and will be available weekdays with fares as outlined below. The schedule is tailored to complement the Reedley College Spring, Summer and Fall semesters. A limited number of free and discounted monthly passes will be made available to qualifying Sanger residents who are attending Reedley College.

The City of Sanger is committed to creating pathways and identifying resources and services to assist our residents with accessibility to job training and to partner with local businesses for job placement. The new Express Transit Route to Reedley College is one component of the Sanger Job Training Program - connecting Sanger residents to vocational skill training to best meet the job skills demands of Sanger businesses, as well as providing direct transportation to Reedley College to pursue higher educational learning opportunities.
