## UPCOMING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS



### • North Avenue Reconstruction – Bethel to Academy Avenue

The project will consist of reconstruction of the existing roadway as part of a cooperative project between the City of Sanger and Fresno County. The final roadway will consist primarily of two through-lanes and a continuous two-way left turn lane to provide for turning movements in and out of cross streets and driveways. Bicycle lanes will be striped in accordance with the 2005 Bicycle Master Plan. The project is projected to commence in late February and last through June. Motorists should be aware of the ongoing construction and prepare for some minor delays associated with construction zone traffic control.

### • State Route 180 Monument Sign

The City of Sanger's contractor will be performing the site work component of the State Route 180 Monument Sign project including demolition, clearing and earthwork and extension of electrical service to the sign. This project will also install perimeter fencing and gate around the sign location. Construction is projected to commence in late February. The installation of the monument sign itself will be performed by Arrow Sign Company of Oakland, CA after the site work is completed, which is projected in early April.

### • Bethel & Cherry In-Roadway Lighted Crosswalk

This project will install an in-roadway lighted (flashing) crosswalk at the intersection of Bethel and Cherry Avenues just west of Madison Elementary with associated traffic signage. The project will be ongoing through the month of March. Motorists should be aware of the construction and prepare for some minor delays associated with construction zone traffic control.

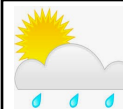
