### **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES (Including but not limited to):**

- Keep score, officiate the players, and manage the coaches and spectators at assigned youth sporting events.
- Ensure that all needed game equipment and supplies are at the field before the start of each game.
- Ensure the field is free of hazards or debris and that the assigned field/court is ready for play.
- Complete game reports and incident/accident reports.
- Assist with the facility set up prior to the game (tables, chairs, chalk /stripe) and break down afterwards.
- May be required to coach a team.
- Perform related work as required.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- At least 16 years of age.
- Able to work weekends and evening hours or on an “on-call” basis & in various weather conditions.
- Experience as a high school player or college player and/or youth sports officiating is desired.
- Candidates selected to work in a position requiring contact with children must submit a certificate or notice documenting that within the last two years they have been examined and found to be free of communicable tuberculosis. The certificate or notice must be signed by a licensed examining physician or public health agency.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

- Knowledge of seasonal sports rules & ability to officiate fairly.
- Ability to understand, explain, interpret, and/or enforce the rules and regulations of the sport which they are officiating.
- Ability to perform physical requirements of: running, jogging, walking, stooping and the ability to lift 25 pounds,
- Ability to write legibly and speak clearly.
- Ability to solve problems encountered by coaches and participants.
- Ability to work well with others.
- Ability to be personable and provide cheerful, helpful service to the public.
- Ability to work well with the Recreation Staff, volunteers and the public.

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**SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

Applications received by the filing date will be reviewed for accuracy, completeness and job-related qualifications. A limited number of persons whose applications clearly demonstrate they most closely meet the requirements may be invited to participate in the selection process - which may be any combination of written, oral and/or performance exams. Before starting work, applicants must present documentation of their identity and authorization to work in the United States.
