1. SUBJECT: Naming of City owned Facilities to Recognize an Individual or Organization:  
Name the new pedestrian bridge on 11<sup>th</sup> Street crossing the Lone Tree Canal "Jefferson Path". A  
presentation was given by the Student Government of Jefferson Elementary School giving a  
history and a recommendation to name the bridge Jefferson Path. The paperwork was submitted  
for review by the Commission for a vote to accept the name. Commissioner Filippi moved to  
accept the name and Commissioner Martinez seconded to motion. Vote to accept: 5-0.

2. SUBJECT: Veterans Park Committee (Information and Discussion only):

Steinhauer: The Committee went to Council to discuss the grant and get answers regarding the grant funds. Mulligan assisted in grant fund explanations. The grant application is due March 1<sup>st</sup> and is currently on track to be submitted. The Committee will continue to meet regularly on Wednesday nights.
