**DEPARTMENT REPORT:**

H-3: SUBJECT: PAR Course Exercise Stations at City Parks(Information and Discussion only):

Mulligan: Presented an overview of the future placement of PAR course exercise stations at various park locations in the City to promote health and wellness. Possible locations would be Jenni Park, JFK Park, and the future Veterans Park. The FY10/11 budget may have funding available for future projects.

Steinhauer: This is a great idea that has been wanted in the City for a long time.

Villarreal: Liked the idea but was concerned for the vandalism.

H-1: SUBJECT: Parks and Recreation Department Report(Information and Discussion only):

Mulligan: Gave updates on the current and future recreation activities such as Gymnastics, Aerobics, Start Smart Baseball, Girls Softball, 4<sup>th</sup> of July Spectacular to be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, Jr. Giants Baseball, and Boxing Tournament, Summer Fun, and swimming. Boys and Girls Club will be starting a summer program called Wacky Wednesday. Boys and Girls Club will also be leasing the PAL building for future programs.

Steinhauer: Likes the Jr. Giant program.

Pinuelas: Concerned that the City still provides the same level of service. Discussed Lincoln Park and community needs now and the future for all park sites.

H-2: Joint Special Meeting: Downtown Beautification:

Mulligan: Discussed the joint meeting of Council and Commissioners regarding the beautification of the Downtown area. Well attended event with plenty of ideas. Talk of the idea of a Christmas Festival downtown. Market the Christmas Tree City better.

Pena: Talked about one way streets downtown on a trial basis

***INFORMATION INITIATED BY COMMISSIONERS:***

Martinez: We continue to talk to old ideas with no action. The City needs more motels to serve the travelers to the mountains which attract people to the area.

Reese: We need to get an organization to take the charge to get the ideas moving. The City should also be looking into retirement homes.

Steinhauer: Wants a “wish list” from Commissioners to come up with ideas to be presented to the Council for action. Wants a PAL building tour. Mentioned a Memorial Day Service at Sanger cemetery at 7AM. There was discussion regarding the river front property and a future park on the site. He wants a copy of an email to the City Manager regarding joint use of the property.

Pena: Wants staff to look into a banner sponsor program to help raise funds for Recreation programs. Other Cities have it and it may be a way to raise funds for programs.

Pinuelas: Remembered a former “wish list” from the 65 acres with old ideas. Likes the Christmas Festival and it needs to be planned now for the future. Also discussed the need to advertise programs better to reach out to people who may not currently be using available programs.
