A RESOLUTION OF THE SANGER CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING  
AND FIXING FEES FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF  
SOLID WASTE, GREEN WASTE AND RECYCLABLES

WHEREAS, Chapter 54 of the Sanger City Code, 1993, authorizes the City Council, by Resolution, to establish and fix fees for the collection, disposal and recycling of various types of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public interest requires it to establish and fix fees as hereinafter specified; and

WHEREAS, the current level of fees for said collection and disposal of solid waste are inadequate to cover the costs of providing such services to the user thereof, and the fees set forth herein are consistent with and do not exceed the cost of providing the collection and disposal services for which the fees are imposed; and

WHEREAS, the data substantiating the cost of providing the services for which the fees are imposed are available for public inspection at least ten (10) days prior to the public meeting at which this Resolution was adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Sanger that the fees for the collection, disposal and recycling of various types of solid waste are hereby established and fixed as follows:

1. Residential Accounts – Single Family

Residential accounts to be picked up a maximum of once per week.

A. Wetwaste

60 gallon or 90 gallon flat rate of twenty three dollars and ten cents (\$23.10) per month.

B. Green waste

100 gallon rate included in Wetwaste Fee.

C. Recycling

96 gallon flat rate of two dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$2.98) per month.

2. Residential – Multi- Family

Residential accounts to be picked up a maximum of once per week.

A. Wetwaste

Two (2) through five (5) living units shall be charged a flat rate of twenty three dollars and ten cents (\$23.10) per month, per unit.

If approved by the Public Works Director, two (2) through five (5) living units can share a 300 gallon container. Refer to commercial rates for fees.

B. Green waste

Rate included in Wetwaste Fee.

C. Recycling

Two (2) through five (5) living units shall be charged a flat rate of two dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$2.98) per month, per unit.

3. Commercial Solid Waste Accounts

Commercial solid waste accounts include the following:

- A. Multi-family six units or more—Recycling Fee shall be a flat rate of one dollar sixty-five cents (\$1.65) per month per unit.
- B. Hotels, Motels
- C. Churches
- D. Schools/Pre-schools
- E. Home catering businesses
- F. Commercial Business/Industry

Commercial accounts are to be described as 300 gallon or 90 gallon containers, picked up five (5), three (3), or one (1) time per week. If approved by the Public Works Director, 300 gallon containers can be shared by up to four (4) users.

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#### 4. Special Services

##### A. Non Residential/Commercial Waste

Wastes excluded in Sanger City Code Section 54-3 to be disposed of per Public Works Director.

B. A City wide clean-up event, for the purpose of collecting special waste, shall occur at a time and location determined by the Public Works Director.

##### C. Tires – Collection and Disposal

The City reserves the right to discontinue the collection and disposal of discarded tires at any time. Disposal fee is as follows:

Passenger Car Tires - \$6.00

Truck Tire - \$9.00

Tractor Tire - \$28.00

#### 5. Return Charge

A. The charge for a return pick up caused by the failure of a customer to respond to a first warning of properly placing the container at a designated service location, not having it placed at time of collection, or if refuse is placed on or around the container preventing proper pick up:

60, 90, or 100 Gallon: \$20.00 per container, per dump

300 Gallon: \$35.00 per container, per dump

B. Contamination Charge: A charge for return pick up that is caused by the failure of a customer to respond to a first warning of separating “wet garbage” from “green waste” or wet garbage” or “green waste” in recyclable shall be:

Written warning for first occurrence

\$25.00 for the second occurrence

\$50.00 for the third occurrence

\$75.00 for the fourth occurrence and each additional occurrence

#### 6. Additional Container of Solid Waste

A. Residential and Commercial Accounts: The full rate per month for each additional container.

#### 7. Container Charges for Special Events/Pick Up

A. Deliveries of container to special events will cost \$15.00 for the first container and \$5.00 for each additional container.

B. First Container – 300 Gallon Container	\$40.00 per collection
90 Gallon Container	\$20.00 per collection

8. The charge for each new, lost, destroyed, or stolen container shall be:

60 gallon	\$ 70.00
90 Gallon	\$ 70.00
100 Gallon	\$ 70.00
300 Gallon	\$225.00

An additional charge of \$250 shall be charged to add wheels to a 300 gallon commercial container.

A delivery charge of \$15.00 shall be charged for each delivery trip to provide new containers or to replace lost, destroyed, or stolen containers.

9. Container Services

- A. Minor Repair – There will be no charge for normal wear and tear. Malicious damage that can be repaired will be billed at actual cost.
- B. Cleaning/Sanitizing Containers – Upon request, or need determined by City, there will be a \$20.00 charge for cleaning/sanitizing each container.
- C. Graffiti Removal—Upon request, or need determined by City, there will be a \$50.00 charge for removal of graffiti from each container.

10. Sanitation – Street Sweeping Fee

- A. Residential Accounts – flat rate of \$1.35 per month.
- B. Commercial Accounts – flat rate of \$1.35 per month.

11. Green waste Drop-Off Fee

- A. Green waste drop-off to Corporate City Yard for Sanger resident only. Drop-off schedule and acceptable green waste will be posted at the City Corporate Yard.
- B. Drop-off fees per occurrence will be as follows:
  - 1. Local Residential and Schools
    - ½ ton truck only \$10.00
    - trailers under 16 ft. in length \$10.00
    - (trailers over 16ft. not allowed)
  - 2. Local Commercial (dropping off residential green waste only)
    - ½ ton truck only \$20.00
    - trailers under 16 ft. in length \$20.00
    - (trailers over 16ft. not allowed)
  - 3. Non-resident green waste will not be accepted.

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12. Consumer Price Index

- A. The fees established in this resolution shall be adjusted beginning on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2008, and shall be adjusted each year thereafter on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June based upon the Consumer Price Index, California, All Urban Consumers for San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose (CPI). The CPI shall be calculated by taking the difference between the most recent CPI data available in April and the CPI data available in April of the previous year.

13. Effective Date of Resolution

- A. This resolution of the Sanger City Council establishing and fixing fees for the collection and disposal of solid waste, green waste and recyclables shall become effective on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2007.

The City reserves the right to discontinue the collection and disposal of discarded tires at any time. Disposal fee is as follows:

- Passenger Car Tires - \$ 6.00
- Truck Tire - \$ 9.00
- Tractor Tire - \$28.00

**5. Return Charge**

*No Changes*

**A.** The charge for a return pick up caused by the failure of a customer to respond to a first warning of properly placing the container at a designated service location, not having it placed at time of collection, or if refuse is placed on or around the container preventing proper pick up:

- 60, 90, or 100 Gallon: \$20.00 per container, per dump
- 300 Gallon: \$35.00 per container, per dump

**B. Contamination Charge:** A charge for return pick up that is caused by the failure of a customer to respond to a first warning of separating “wet garbage” from “green waste” or wet garbage” or “green waste” in recyclable shall be:

- Written warning for first occurrence
- \$25.00 for the second occurrence
- \$50.00 for the third occurrence
- \$75.00 for the fourth occurrence and each additional occurrence

**6. Additional Container of Solid Waste**

**A. Residential and Commercial Accounts:** The full rate per month for each additional container.

**7. Container Charges for Special Events/Pick Up**

*No Changes*

**A.** Deliveries of container to special events will cost \$15.00 for the first container and \$5.00 for each additional container.

**B.** First Container – 300 Gallon Container - \$40.00  
90 Gallon Container - \$20.00

**8. The charge for each new, lost, destroyed, or stolen container shall be:**

*No Changes*

- 60 gallon - \$ 70.00
- 90 Gallon - \$ 70.00
- 100 Gallon - \$ 70.00
- 300 Gallon - \$225.00

An additional charge of \$250 shall be charged to add wheels to a 300 gallon commercial container.

A delivery charge of \$15.00 shall be charged for each delivery trip to provide new containers or to replace lost, destroyed, or stolen containers.

**9. Container Services**

*No Changes*

**A. Minor Repair –** There will be no charge for normal wear and tear. Malicious damage that can be repaired will be billed at actual cost.

**B. Cleaning/Sanitizing Containers –** Upon request, or need determined by City, there will be a \$20.00 charge for cleaning/sanitizing each container.

**C. Graffiti Removal—**Upon request, or need determined by City, there will be a \$50.00 charge for removal of graffiti from each container.
