Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Possess a willingness to become involved in the community
- Must pass a background check
- Must be in good physical condition and present a physician-signed medical waiver
- Must have a valid CA Driver License and maintain a satisfactory driving record
- No Felony Convictions
- No recent illegal drug use
- No outstanding arrest warrants
- Must sign a personal injury waiver
- Successfully complete our Volunteer training, driver's training course, and field training
- Willing to work a minimum of eight
 (8) hours per month with a minimum one (1) year time commitment
- Willing to attend required meetings/ trainings
