   RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve.
- 2. <u>SUBJECT:</u> Final Acceptance Cherry Avenue Reconstruction.

  <u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> That the City Council: 1) Accept the work for Cherry Avenue Reconstruction between Bethel and Greenwood Avenues in the amount of \$376,700.008; 2) Authorize recordation of the Notice of Completion with the Fresno County Recorder; and 3) Authorize payment of 5% retention in the amount of \$18,835.00 to Valley Excavation, Inc. upon expiration of the 35-day lien period.
